Hi Kylie – I tried to call you before and was not able to get hold of you. I also tried Lee Anderson and left a message. I am looking for a response today from the Premier and Qld Govt generally on the fact that Jann Stuckey has lost another staff person. I am yet to contact Jann about this, but I will do so soon.

This story is running tomorrow, so I would appreciate a response back by 3pm if possible.

1. After 9 staff members have left Jann Stuckey's Ministerial or Electoral office in just 9 months, what plans does the government have to investigate or address this situation?
2. Have any staff members, who worked for Ms Stuckey, made formal complaints about suffering bullying or harassment from Ms Stuckey?
3. Have any staff members made complaints generally about Ms Stuckey being difficult to work with?
4. Indep MP Alex Douglas has called for an investigation by the government and leadership by Mr Newman on this issue. Does the Premier Campbell Newman have plans to investigate how Ms Stuckey manages her staff after such a high staff turnover was recorded?
5. Mr Douglas believes each previous staff member should be interviewed to find out what the issues are, is that something Mr Newman would consider?
